LIGHTING THE CHRIST CANDLE

Reader 1: Beloved, today we welcome the Christ Child, the fulfillment of our joy, as we proclaim with the prophet Isaiah, "For a child has been born for us, a son given to us; authority rests upon his shoulders; and he is named Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace" (Isaiah 9:6).

"His authority shall grow continually, and there shall be endless peace for the throne of David and his kingdom.
